All entries received after 8:00 PM THURSDAY before the show will be charged a late fee of \$50.00 in addition to all other fees.

Membership Requirements: All exhibitors must be current members of the Central Texas Schooling Show Association (CTSSA). Memberships are \$20.00 for individuals and \$35.00 for families and may be paid at the show.

Payment: Bring a blank check to the show. DO NOT fill out the check before you arrive.

Credit cards are not accepted.

Prizes: Trophies and ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Championship trophy and ribbon and reserve ribbon will be awarded in each division. Hunt 'n' Go will award ribbons  $1^{st} - 8^{th}$  place.

Attire: Appropriate attire required. Coats are optional. Approved helmets must be worn by ALL riders while mounted, including those in the warmup ring. Numbers must be worn and be clearly visible.

Health requirements: In accordance with the requirements of the State of Texas, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by a negative coggins.

#### **CLASS SPECIFICATIONS**

#### TROT POLES

Open to very beginner riders. The course will be made up of four poles on the ground. NO cantering. Riders in this division are allowed to cross enter ONLY into the cross-rail divisions.

- 1. Trot Poles Hunter Over Poles
- 2. Hunter I Over Poles
- 3. Hunter II Over Poles
- 4. Trot Poles Equitation Over Poles
- 5. Trot Poles Hunter Under Saddle
- 6. Trot Poles Equitation on the Flat

#### **CROSS RAIL HUNTER DIVISION**

Open to all beginners. The course may be trotted or cantered. A horse may be ridden by more than one rider and each rider/horse combination receives championship points and year end points. Riders in this division may cross ONLY into one division down (Trot Poles) or one division up (18" Vertical Hunter).

- 8. Cross Rail Hunter Over Fences II

#### **CROSS RAIL EQUITATION DIVISION**

Open to all beginners. The course may be trotted or cantered. A horse may be ridden by more than one rider and each rider/horse combination receives championship points and year end points. Riders in this division may cross ONLY into either one division down (Trot Poles) or one division up (18" Vertical Hunter).

#### 18" VERTICAL HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all beginners. The course will be made up of simple fences in Ring 2. Riders in this division may cross ONLY into either one division down (Cross Rail Hunter) or one division up (2' Hunter, Ring 1).

#### **SPECIAL CLASSES (no CTSSA points):**

100. HUNT TEAMS CLASS Open only to horses and ponies who have competed in one of the regular hunter or pony hunter sections. Teams of three horses or ponies, shown over a short course in the derby field, one to follow the other at a safe hunting distance. Final jump is synchronized. Teams may wear costumes compatible with riding a hunt course. Judged on performance, suitability, manners, uniformity and appearance as a team. Fences: 2'. Horse/pony and/or rider may only compete on one team.
