All entries received after 8:00 PM THURSDAY before the show will be charged a late fee of \$50.00 in addition to all other fees.

Membership Requirements: All exhibitors must be current members of the Central Texas Schooling Show Association (CTSSA). Memberships are \$20.00 for individuals and \$35.00 for families and may be paid at the show.

Payment: Bring a blank check to the show. DO NOT fill out the check before you arrive.

Credit cards are not accepted.

Prizes: Trophies and ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Championship trophy and ribbon and reserve ribbon will be awarded in each division. Handy Hunter will award ribbons $1^{st} - 8^{th}$ place, and prize money $1^{st} - 6^{th}$. 1-30%, 2-22%, 3-16%, 4-14%, 5-10%, 6-8%.

Attire: Appropriate attire required. Coats are optional. Approved helmets must be worn by ALL riders while mounted, including those in the warmup ring. Numbers must be worn and be clearly visible.

Health requirements: In accordance with the requirements of the State of Texas, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by a negative coggins.

Entry forms must be signed before you school your horse

Open to very beginner riders. The course will be made up of four poles on the ground. NO cantering. Riders in this division are allowed to cross enter ONLY into the cross-rail divisions.
