Prizes: Each class and division will get ribbons for 1st -6th place. Hunter/Jumper divisions will have Champion and Reserve Champion awards. Steeplechase and Handy Hunter class (must have ten riders) -- Prize money will be awarded as follows: \$350 1-\$85 2-\$70 3-\$55 4-\$45 5-\$35 6-\$25 7-\$20 8-\$15
If fewer than 10 riders, class will be held as jackpot class – 30,22,16,14,10,8 per cent distributed. Prize money will be deducted from show bill.

Attire: Helmets are required by all mounted riders. Safety vests are required for Steeplechase and are strongly encouraged for the Handy Hunter. Proper footwear required - matching half chaps and paddock boots are acceptable. No t-shirts allowed. Please make sure your ASTM/SEI certified helmet is properly fitted!

Training/Assistance: This is a schooling show and we want everyone to feel successful. We will permit trainers in the ring to assist riders who are having difficulties. Horses will be allowed 4 refusals at a fence before being excused in the interests of time. Please note that riders are encouraged to progress incrementally: each horse/rider combination may enter **any three consecutive height divisions** (examples: Short/Long Stirrup, 2', 2'3"; 2'3", 2'6", 2'9"; etc), giving them every opportunity. *NOTE: There are no oxers in SS/LS or 2'.*

Arenas: 120' x 130' sand arena for warm-up. 200' x 130' jumping arena. Grass jumping arenas. Covered 20m x 60m sand dressage arena for tests and flat classes. Round pen is also available. Please keep the arena areas quiet for exhibitors.

Stabling: \$45/stall. Includes fresh shavings. Stabling is available on received entry first-come basis. Bring your own feed/hay/buckets. Check in starts Friday prior to event at 1pm. All rings are open to stalled horses for schooling the Friday before the show at 2 pm. Small paddocks also available (with shelter)

Campers: RV Hook ups are available at \$45 per night

Weather Changes: All show date changes due to weather will be noted on the Facebook group page. If there is no mention of cancellation or postponement, the show is being held as scheduled.

Parking: Parking starts at the gate. Please park on sides of driveway with vehicle completely clear of driveway. Trailer parking is in the North pasture in back; please follow signs.

Coggins: Proof of a current Coggins test must be shown when checking in.

HUNTER CLASSES/DIVISIONS: \$18 per class/round, Lindsey Mortimer, Judge

Short/Long Stirrup: – Sponsored by Anne Budroni and Gemini. Simple course of cross rails and 15” verticals.

Includes change of direction. No oxers. Classes: Hunter 1 and 2, Hunter Under Saddle.

2' Hunters – Sponsored by Nataly Lim and Orlando. Simple course with change of direction both ways. No oxers. Riders may trot lead changes. Judged on temperament and performance. Classes: Hunter 1 and 2, Hunter Under Saddle.

2'3” Hunters - Simple course with change of direction both ways. Oxers. Judged on temperament and performance.

Classes: Hunter 1 and 2, Hunter Under Saddle.

2'6” Hunters - Course will include bending lines and an in and out. Judged on performance. Classes: Hunter 1 and 2, Hunter Under Saddle.

2'9” Hunters - Course will include in and out with oxer to a vertical and a Swedish oxer. Judged on performance. Classes: Hunter 1 and 2, Hunter Under Saddle.

3' Hunters - Sponsored by Amelia Nonemacher and Ultraviolet. Course will include in-and-out with oxer to a vertical and a Swedish oxer. Judged on performance.

Classes: Hunter 1 and 2, Hunter Under Saddle.

** Each division will have a warm-up class. Ribbons for 1st – 6th; Champion and Reserve for every division with at least 3 horses/class.

JUMPER CLASSES/DIVISIONS: \$18 per class/round

2' Jumpers: Classes: Time 1st Jump Off and Power & Speed

2'3" Jumpers: Classes: Time 1st Jump Off and Power & Speed

2' 6" Jumpers: Classes: Time 1st Jump Off and Power & Speed

2' 9" Jumpers: Classes: Time 1st Jump Off and Power & Speed

3' Jumpers: Classes: Time 1st Jump Off and Power & Speed

3'3" Jumpers: Classes: Time 1st Jump Off and Power & Speed

** Each division will have a Champion and Reserve if classes have at least 3 riders. Flowers and solids in at the 2' division. Oxers starting at 2'3". Course may change between 2'3" and 2'6". Jumps are colored and decorated as well as numbered to help riders remember courses.

DRESSAGE TESTS: \$20/test, Sponsored by Carol Peters and Traveler,

Introductory Level – Tests A, B, and C

Training Level – Tests 1, 2, and 3

First Level – Tests 1, 2, and 3

*Dressage entries are due February 27th, 2019 by 7 PM. Times will be posted at show and on Facebook page.

**Riders may enter through Fourth Level. Select OTHER on entry form and write in level and tests.

MEDAL CLASSES: \$18 per class/round

2'6" Medal: Course of not less than 8 obstacles with a combination and may include colored rails. At least 4 exhibitors will be called back for the ride-off tests which may include Tests 1-18 as listed in the USEF Rule Book.

2'9" Medal: Course of not less than 8 obstacles with a combination and may include colored rails. At least 4 exhibitors will be called back for the ride-off tests which may include Tests 1-18 as listed in the USEF Rule Book.

3' Medal: Course of not less than 8 obstacles with a combination and may include colored rails. At least 4 exhibitors will be called back for the ride-off tests which may include Tests 1-18 as listed in the USEF Rule Book.

SPECIAL CLASSES: \$30 per class

Must have a minimum of 10 entries in order to be held, otherwise class will be held as a jackpot class.

\$300 Handy Hunter Challenge: *Sponsored by Sandra Heinrichs and Silver Hill Stables.*

Fences shall be set for each level – 2'6"; 2'9"; and 3'. This course includes test skills riders and their horses might use during an enjoyable day of foxhunting, combining the elements of flat and over-fences classes. A handy hunter is a horse or pony that is very easy to maneuver around a course in the hunt field. Different elements that might be seen in a handy hunter course include, but are not limited to, fences at the gallop, rollbacks, trot fences, a gate to open and/or close from the horse's back, etc. Judged and numerically scored on quality, movement, jumping style, handiness, manners and way of going. Pace and brilliance are to be rewarded. ***This class is not appropriate for a green horse/pony or a novice rider.***

\$350 Steeplechase: *Sponsored by Eleanor Fitzgerald.*

SAFETY VEST REQUIRED. Non-professional riders only. Jumps are 2'3" wooden brush boxes with natural brush. Ten hurdle jumps that collapse on impact. Staff will man each jump and will eliminate riders who exhibit dangerous behavior.

Time rules for steeplechase:

Exceeding the optimum time: 0.4 penalties per second

Exceeding the time limit: elimination (going too slow)

Trotting, walking or circling on course to add time will result in elimination; **for each second under the speed fault time: 0.4 penalties**
